



OVER 55 LBS. REGULATIONS CHECKLIST

Complete the Regulations Consulting Form

Fill out the contact form to work with the Agri Spray Drones regulations consultant and note which exemptions you would like included in your petition. You should receive this form link via email once you purchase the regulations consulting package. By completing the form, you initiate the process for your 137 and 44807 exemptions.

Register your Drone

You must register your drone with the FAA to receive the Part 137 certification and obtain insurance. You can register your drone as an LLC or as an individual. Please note: ALL DOCUMENTS SUBMITTED MUST MATCH. For example: If your aircraft invoice is listed in the LLC company name, then the 8050-1 application and all other documents must also be in the company name.

Become 107 Certified

- Obtain an FAA Tracking Number (FTN) by creating an Integrated Airman Certification and Rating Application (IACRA) profile.
- Schedule an appointment with an FAA-approved Knowledge Testing Center.
- Complete and pass the initial aeronautical knowledge test: "Unmanned Aircraft General - Small (UAG)".

Schedule and Complete Your FAA Medical Certificate Appointment

Obtain Your State Pesticide Applicator License

Meet with Flight Standards District Offices (FSDO)

Once you receive the petition documents from the regulations consultant, schedule a time with your FSDO to do a verbal evaluation and for them to watch you fly.

Get Applicator Insurance

44807 Exemption Received

After you receive your 44807 drone exemption, you will complete the 8710-3 form located at the end of your returned exemption. Once you complete the form, you will email it to the 137 UAS Operations Office for review and approval.
